DESERT CHALLENGE GAMES

The Desert Challenge Games is a multi-day sports competition hosted by Arizona Disabled Sports for individuals with physical, visual, or intellectual disabilities. As a part of The Hartford competition series with Move United, the Desert Challenge Games provide the opportunity for national and international athletes to compete in Air Gun, Archery, Swimming and Track & Field with the hope of qualifying for National Championships or the US Veteran Games.

HISTORY OF DESERT CHALLENGE GAMES

The Desert Challenge Games began in 1991 as a collaborative effort between the Mesa Association of Sports for the Disabled (now known as Arizona Disabled Sports) and the Far West Wheelchair Association. 100 athletes from California, Nevada, Utah and Arizona competed in Track & Field, Swimming, Table Tennis, Archery and Power Lifting events. Participant numbers steadily increased over the years and in 2014 the Desert Challenge Games was granted status as the only International Paralympic Committee Grand Prix event in North America. Today, the Desert Challenge Games serve over 400 youth, adult and veteran athletes from around the world, all with the purpose of encouraging international competition, supporting excellence in sport, and enhancing the overall quality of life for individuals living with a disability.

2024 DESERT CHALLENGE GAMES

The 2024 Desert Challenge Games will be held May 28-June 2 in Mesa & Tempe, Arizona. Athletes will compete in Air Gun, Archery, Swimming and Track & Field events. Updates for Desert Challenge Games can be found on our website at www.desertchallengegames.com.
