

Hello Athletes,

Please review the International Classification schedules listed on this website to verify your date and time for classification. **If you are no longer able to attend the event or commit to being available for classification, please let [Bryce Boarman](#) know immediately.** There may be some minor updates to the schedule regarding appointment times due to the technical assessment time changing, but there should not be any major changes to the attached schedules. If there are changes to the schedule I will send out updates as soon as I receive them.

Here are a few key reminders regarding your classification appointment:

- Athletes must be present at the classification location 30 minutes before the allocated time on the classification schedule.
- Athletes must bring a passport or some other official form of identification along with their accreditation
- Athletes should bring hard copies of any medical documentation they have turned in and any other relevant medical documentation they have.
- Athletes may be accompanied by one athlete representative. This can be a parent, coach, US Paralympics staff, etc.
- Athletes must attend with all sports equipment and attire used in competition for the technical assessment portion.
- Athletes must ensure their throwing frames/racing wheelchairs are at the technical assessment location, if applicable.
- Athletes with Visual Impairments must bring the visual correction aids used in training and competition to classification.
